➤ **The situation of evacuation from East Galilee:**

12,291 are evacuated to hotels

28,200 are evacuated in the community (not staying in hotels).

➤ **Employment and economy:**

In July 2024 there were 7,901 job seekers in the East Galilee Cluster

Of whom 1,393 (18%) had an academic degree.

➤ **Opening of the School Year**

The school year started when approximately 40,000 residents from the East Galilee Cluster were evacuated from their homes, including 9,336 children aged 0-18.

The residents of Rajar stayed in their community and maintained their educational system, which included two Kindergartens, one elementary school, and one middle and High school.

In the regional council of Mevoo't Hahermon, 3,851 citizens were evacuated.

Shchafim Special Needs School was transferred to a temporary school near Rosh Pinna due to the war.

Five kindergartens are close (Ramot Naftali, Margalioth, Beit Hilel, Kfar Yuval and Shear Yeshuv).

Ten kindergartens work normally and embrace many evacuated kids.

Two special needs kindergartens are close

Seven daycares work normally

Two daycares are close (Margalioth, Beit Hilel).



- As part of the study of youth in the non-evacuated localities that is currently being analyzed, focus groups were also conducted alongside surveys with girls and boys in grades 7-9 who made their voices and important feelings about the war year heard .

As part of the recognition for their participation in research, the youth had an artist meeting with actor Daniel Litman. It was an exciting meeting .
